



# Resource Enhancement and Protection FY 2012-13 Program

## What's New!

### Submission Information

The SCC will have two separate application periods for the FY 2012-13 program.

- **The first application period** (beginning August 1, 2012) will accept applications for COMPLETED projects only. The SCC will reserve 75% of the total REAP allocation for this funding round.
- **The second application period** (beginning August 29, 2012) will accept applications for both proposed and completed projects. If there are additional credits that were not awarded from the first application period, those credits will be added to the second application periods allocation. If the amount of completed applications received in the first funding round, exceeds the 75% allocation, those applications will be reviewed as part of the second funding round.

### Eligibility for Non-CAO and Non-CAFO

All operations that have any livestock, poultry or equine or utilize or handle manure will be required to have at minimum a Manure Management Plan (DEP MMP) under DEP Chapter 91 regulations in order to be eligible for REAP tax credits, or must agree to have one written, prior to the release of tax credits for any other project. Please see attachment 9 of the REAP program guidelines for additional information.

### Changes to BMPs/Eligible Projects

**Additions** – Manure Management Plan – DEP Chapter 91

**Remove the following REAP BMPs**

- REAP application and verification fee
- Clearing and Snagging (326)
- Subsurface Drainage (607)
- Waste Utilization (633)

**Changes to the following BMPS**

- Cover Crop(340) – Seed cost and Planting and Equipment cost only
- Heavy Use Protection (561) – SCC staff site visit required to document the need for a roof structure prior to BMPS approval.
- Spring Development (574) – Practice may include a maximum of 1,200 feet of 4 inch collection line only
